Over the years, this landmark has been used as a royal residence, a prison, the treasury, the Royal Mint, a records office, and as a house for the Crown Jewels.

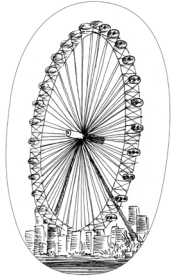
**Clue Number One:**

The official residence of the UK's sovereign since 1837.



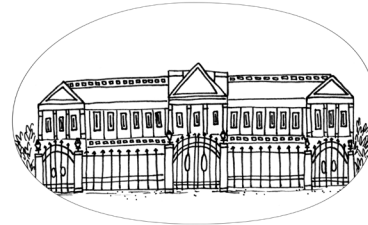
**Clue Number Two:**
